

## REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL KOOTENAY

### BYLAW NO. 1642

A Bylaw to establish a service within a portion of Electoral Area D for the purpose of providing mosquito control.

WHEREAS a regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate a service under the provisions of Part 24 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay deems it expedient to establish a service within a portion of Electoral Area D for the purpose of providing mosquito control;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Sections 801(2)(a) of the *Local Government Act*, the assent of the electors within the participating area has been obtained in accordance with Section 801.2 of the *Local Government Act*.

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Regional District hereby establishes a service within a portion of Electoral Area D, to be known as the "Pineridge Subdivision Area Mosquito Control Service", for the purpose of providing mosquito control services.
2. The sole participant to the service established under Section 1 of this bylaw shall be a portion of Electoral Area D.
3. The boundaries for the service established under Section 1 of this bylaw shall be that portion of Electoral Area D as shown on Schedule A and shall be known as the "Pineridge Subdivision Area Mosquito Control Service Area".
4. The annual cost of providing the service shall be recovered by means of a property value tax to be imposed on the basis of the net taxable value of land and improvements in the participating area in accordance with section 804.3(5)(a) of the *Local Government Act* to be collected under Section 806.1.
5. Provision of the service will commence in 2004 with the costs of the referendum to be included as part of the first year operating costs of the service.
6. The maximum amount of money that may be requisitioned annually under Section 806.1(1)(a) shall not exceed:

- (a) For the year 2004, the greater of \$15,000 or \$1.95 per \$1,000 of the net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area.
- (b) Commencing in the year 2005, the greater of \$13,000 or \$1.69 per \$1,000 of the net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the amount of the maximum requisition for the year 2004 will be collected in 2005 in conjunction with the 2005 requisition unless assessment coding for taxation purposes is in place in time for the 2004 requisition.

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **"Pineridge Subdivision Area Mosquito Control Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1642, 2003."**


