Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures in effect for the Balfour, Burton, Denver Siding, Grandview Properties, McDonald Creek, Sanca, West Robson, and Woodbury Village water systems.

Nelson, BC: Effective immediately, mandatory **Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures** are being implemented in the Balfour, Burton, Denver Siding, Grandview Properties, McDonald Creek, Sanca, West Robson, and Woodbury Village water systems.

Water conservation measures have been rescinded in Edgewood and Fauquier water system due to wildfire mitigation efforts.

The **Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures** have been implemented due to continued hot weather and the Provincial request for a voluntary 30% reduction in water consumption.

"The West Kootenays are currently listed at drought level three [out of five] and the Province is requesting a voluntary 30% reduction in water withdrawal on licensed water quantity," said Steve Ethier, RDCK Water Operations Manager. "The Regional District water systems will aim for this current reduction amount, and any further Provincial requests for conservation, to ensure there is adequate supply for potential wildfire concerns and mitigation efforts".

Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures include:

- Watering of lawns, gardens, trees and shrubs is ONLY permitted between 6:00am-10:00am and 8:00pm-10:00pm.
- Watering of gardens, trees and shrubs by watering can or hand-held hose is still permitted anytime.

The RDCK appreciates your cooperation in adhering to the above water conservation measures. **Stage 2 Water Conservation Measures** will remain in effect until further notice. Stricter water conservation measures may be required if demand increases significantly, hot and dry weather persists, or if the Province requests additional conservation efforts.
