The Evacuation Order, pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the *BC Emergency Program Act* issued at 20:22 on May 2, 2023 to the Little Slokan South Road has been reduced.

Pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the *BC Emergency Program Act* an Evacuation Order has been issued by the Regional District of Central Kootenay due to immediate danger to life safety caused by a debris flow hazard.

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police and other agencies will be expediting this action in these areas on behalf of the Regional District of Central Kootenay. A debris flow poses imminent threat to people and property. Based on recommendations from a qualified professional, the Evacuation Order remains in effect for the following address (see attached map):

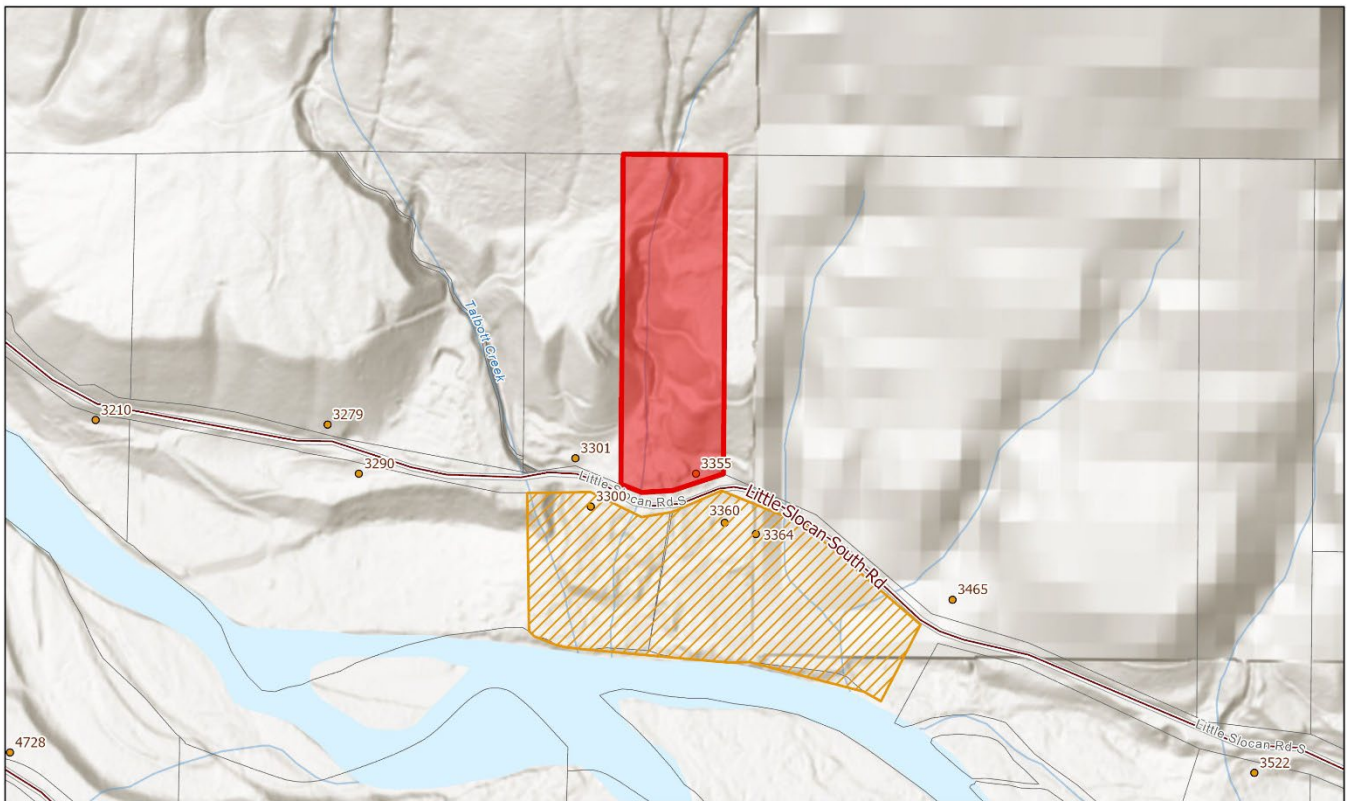

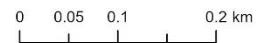
