



Lower Kootenay Band Waste Disposal Declaration Form

Prior to waiving tipping fees for disposals at the Creston Landfill, RDCK requires any Lower Kootenay Band (LKB) members with loads that are not obviously residential in nature, or with advanced authorization from the RDCK using the Waste Disposal Application form, to declare the waste through the completion of this form.

Disposals that are not verified by the LKB Band Office as having been generated by LKB members and originating from LKB member owned property will be billed the tonnage rate as set out in Schedule A-3 of the most recent RDCK Resource Recovery Facilities Regulatory Bylaw.

Once this form is completed, it must be emailed to RRDept@rdck.bc.ca at least 48 hours prior to disposal.

AGREEMENT TERMS – RDCK and LKB

During the term of this agreement solid waste from Lower Kootenay Band members will be accepted at the Creston Landfill for no charge. The RDCK requires the following to enable management of this practice:

- Material loads must be generated by Lower Kootenay Band members and from property that is owned by a member.
- Proof of membership is required prior to disposal. This can come in the form of a status card or advanced confirmation from the Lower Kootenay Band office to RDCK.
- Material can be delivered by a non-band member if the Lower Kootenay Band office receives advanced authorization from the RDCK using the Waste Disposal Application form.
- Material loads equal to or larger than the equivalent of a dump truck (approximately 7.5m³) require advance notice to the RDCK using the Waste Disposal Application form.
- All materials brought to the RDCK landfill must be treated in a manner that adheres with the current Resource Recovery Regulatory Bylaw, including but not limited to: Schedule B: Recyclable Materials, Schedule C: Controlled Materials, and Schedule D: Prohibited Materials.
- Any person using the Creston Landfill must adhere to the RDCK's Resource Recovery Facilities Bylaw.
