There are many small, simple changes we can make as individuals to help reduce the amount of waste going into our landfills. With more options to recycle, repurpose and return items than ever before, many people may not be aware of the steps they can take to help our environment.

The RDCK is now seeking applications for the Waste Spotter position this summer in Nakusp. This is a part-time, seasonal position aimed at providing on-site public education to reduce unnecessary disposal practices and achieve compliance with RDCK Resource Recovery bylaws and policies. The Waste Spotter will provide on-site inspection and information to users, assisting them to properly dispose of, recycle and return items in compliance with set standards.

The position will commence in May 2017 for the summer (up to four months, weather permitting). The successful application will work an average of 12 hours per week and work a flexible schedule which will include weekends. Shifts will typically be 3-6 hours. The RDCK is also hiring Waste Spotters at other locations. Candidates are welcome to apply across multiple areas.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- ◆ Passion for Zero Waste and environmental issues
- ◆ One year work experience in a customer service position, with experience enforcing company policies/standards
- ◆ Prior experience with public education or working with the public at a one-on-one level

- ◆ Excellent interpersonal communication skills with demonstrated ability to deal with upset customers
- ◆ Prior experience in the field of waste management would be considered an asset
