SUMMARY OF POSITION:

The Rosebery Threeforks Parks and Trail Maintenance Worker is responsible for maintaining the Galena Trail, from Rosebery to Three Forks, Rosebery Parklands and Bigelow Bay.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Maintain outhouses and stock toilet paper using RDCK supplies.
- 2. Restock brochure racks.
- 3. Monitor condition of all structures, outhouses, bridges, and cable car for safety concerns and take adequate measures to repair or report issues to supervisor.
- 4. Make note of and repair sloughs and slumps on the trail.
- 5. Make note of and clear brush or fallen trees on trail.
- 6. Maintain trail signage.
- 7. Mow trail with lawnmower provided by RDCK.
- 8. Clear rocks from trail.
- 9. Clear bridges of fallen leaves.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Ownership of own mountain bike that is in adequate repair.
- Ability to complete a 14 kilometre ride and complete the required inspection and light maintenance work on each 7 kilometre segment of trail in a 4 hour time period.
- Experience using hand and power tools.
- Knowledge of the area.
- Basic First Aid.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Constant movement, including stooping, bending, reaching, twisting and kneeling
- Working alone in remote areas
- Exposure to varied weather
- Occasional lifting up to 25 kg.
