



LIFEGUARDS/SWIM INSTRUCTORS

The Regional District of Central Kootenay (RDCK) is inviting applications for Part-Time Lifeguard/Swim Instructor positions working in the Nelson & District Community Complex. Hours of work may include morning, afternoon, evening and/or weekend shifts.

Interested individuals are encouraged to submit their application for the position(s) they are already qualified for. Successful applicants will be expected to achieve qualification to perform both rolls within three months of hire.

LIFEGUARDS

Lifeguards are responsible for the supervision and safety of patrons at all times through public education, training, and proactive response to potential situations. Examples of duties include but are not limited to lifeguarding, which involves observing and safe guarding activities in an aquatic environment, providing assistance to swimmers in difficulty and rendering first aid treatment as required and ensuring customer safety and enjoyment by maintaining a clean environment

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Current NLS certification
- Current CPR certification (attained within last 12 months)
- Current Standard First Aid (AEC preferred)
- Current AED certification
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Persons Screening

SWIM INSTRUCTORS

The Swim Instructor is responsible for ensuring the safety of participants while providing instruction for preschool, children and adult programs. Examples of duties include but are not limited to the direct supervision of assigned groups of participants, organization of equipment and materials before and after each lesson, completion of administrative tasks for each lesson and the demonstration of skills and include a variety of teaching methods of activities.

REQUIRED LICENSES, CERTIFICATES and REGISTRATIONS:

- Current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification
- Current CPR C recertified annually

These are part-time positions working less than 25 hours per week. The successful candidates must be available to work a varied work schedule that includes weekdays, weekends, and evening shifts. These are Union (CUPE) positions and the current rate of pay is \$17.38 per hour for Lifeguards and \$17.97 per hour for Swim Instructors as per the collective agreement. An additional 15% in lieu of benefits will be added to every pay cheque.
