The Regional District of Central Kootenay (RDCK) is inviting applications for the positions of Summer Camp Program Leaders and Program Monitors at the Nelson & District Community Complex.

We are looking for enthusiastic, creative people who enjoy spending lots of time outdoors working with children and young people in a fun, educational setting. These are high energy positions and require a variety of skills including friendly, professional communication, problem solving and team work.

Areas of Program Leadership include: Skateboard/Scooter, Sailing, Paddle, Art, Science, Special Interest—let us know what interests you!

These are term positions, beginning mid June and ending in early September 2019. Calls for interviews will take place on in the second week on May and applicants should be available to participate in interviews on May 14, 2019.

PROGRAM LEADERS:

Recreation Program Leader is responsible for the supervision and instruction of a variety of recreation sport and leisure programs. The employee is responsible for assisting in the program planning, general safety and overall enjoyment of the patrons attending the program.

Hours of work are variable and schedules specific to each program. Hours may include morning, afternoon, evening and/or weekend shifts.

Hours of work will vary depending on program needs. The successful candidates may be expected to work a varied schedule that may include day, weekend, and/or evening shifts.

Program Monitors are responsible for the set-up and delivery of a variety of recreational programs for all ages. The employees are responsible for the participating in all program activities, providing first aid, communicating safety concerns and dealing with patron behaviors during all schedule programs and shifts.
