The Castlegar & District Community Complex is currently inviting applications for the positions of Summer Camp Leader for our summer camp programs. Reporting to the Recreation & Cultural Programmer, the successful individuals will be responsible for supervision and instruction of recreation sport and leisure summer camps. Camp Leaders are responsible for the program planning, general safety and overall enjoyment of the patrons attending the camps, in a variety of settings.

There are four positions available. These are term positions, beginning June 24th, 2019 and ending late August, 2019. Hours of work range from 20 to 40 per week and are specific to the programs scheduled. Assigned shifts may include days, evenings and weekends and will be scheduled on an as needed basis.

At least one of the successful candidates will hold a Water Safety Instructor Certification.

**Due to funding conditions, candidates must be youths between the ages of 15-30**

**OR full-time students returning to school in the fall.**

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE:

- Current CPR "C" and Standard First Aid certification or equivalent.
- Strong verbal communication skills, including excellent customer service skills
- Proficiency and confidence in working with children 5 – 15 years of age
- Skills, expertise and experience leading recreational sport programs, inclusive games and/or arts and cultural programs
- Ability to demonstrate program planning skills and behavior management strategies
- Ability to work independently and problem solve
- Demonstrated leadership abilities
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record
- National Coaching Certificate Program certificate, recreation leadership training, i.e. High Five, Fundamental Movement Skills or other Sport For Life program certificate would be considered an asset.
- Water Safety Instructor (WSI) Certification may be a requirement for some of our camps
