The Regional District of Central Kootenay (RDCK) is inviting applications for the positions of **Lifeguards and Swim Instructors** at the Creston & District Community Complex.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- National Lifeguard Certification (Current, and not set to expire for a minimum of three months)
- Standard First Aid current within two years
- Current CPR C recertified annually
- Standard First Aid or equivalent
- WHMIS Certification
- Current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification (For Swim Instructor Position)
- Other appropriate aquatic awards would be considered an asset
- Satisfactory Criminal Record

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- 16 years of age (minimum)
- Knowledge of the methods, tools, and equipment used in life guarding
- Knowledge of life guarding rules, regulations and practices

Lifeguards join a great team of people to monitor pool use, provide assistance to swimmers in difficulty and render first aid treatment when required.

Swim Instructors are responsible for ensuring the safety of participants while providing instruction for preschool, children and adult programs.

- Knowledge of WHMIS procedures
- Knowledge of emergency procedures
- Ability to deal courteously and effectively with the public
- Ability to work with minimal supervision, exercise considerable independence of judgment / action

These are part-time positions and the successful applicants will work up to 24 hours per week. The successful candidates must be available to work a varied work schedule based on operational demands that includes day, weekend, and/or evening shifts. The current rate of pay when working as a Lifeguard is \$24.81 and when working as a Swim Instructor is \$22.26 per hour.
