The Regional District of Central Kootenay (RDCK) is inviting applications for the full time permanent position of **Aquatic Leader** at the Creston & District Community Complex.

Under the general direction of the Head Lifeguard, the Aquatic Leader is a member of the Aquatics Leadership team

The position provides mentorship to staff while performing lifeguard and instructional duties, performs a variety of custodial & maintenance tasks in the aquatic areas and assisting with the operation and delivery of aquatic programs, recreation programs and special events.

This role requires the individual to demonstrate leadership abilities and possess a strong knowledge of operating procedures.

The Aquatic Leader is positive and responsive when dealing with the public and user groups and performs as a professional and dedicated team player in providing the best possible aquatic service to the community.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Minimum 1 year of Supervisory experience plus a minimum 1 full-time year in Aquatics or acceptable equivalent combination of experience
- Knowledge of methods, rules, regulations, practices, tools & equipment required in lifeguarding
- WHMIS certification & knowledge of emergency procedures
- Ability to work with minimal supervision, exercise considerable independence of judgment / action in the operation of the aquatic center
- Strong Leadership and team qualities for supervisory and peer interactions and relationships
- Demonstrated ability to effectively manage workplace conflict with co-workers and de-escalate patron issues

- Ability to demonstrate ownership of personal development and the development of the team as a whole
- Demonstrated ability to assess the performance of aquatic staff and to provide appropriate and timely feedback in response
- Ability to meet various deadlines in a constantly changing service environment
- High level of creativity and flexibility and a willingness to adapt to change
- Commitment to the RDCK Values: Health and safety, Integrity, Accountability and Respect

This is a full time position working 35 hours per week, the current rate of pay when working as an Aquatic Leader is \$27.13 per hour.
