This position will provide coverage for a leave and is anticipated to be for approximately 2 month term, or until the return of the incumbent.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Knowledge of the methods, tools, and equipment used in life guarding.
- Knowledge of life guarding rules, regulations and practices.
- Knowledge of WHMIS procedures.
- Knowledge and ability to give first aid, CPR and instruction in the pool.
- Knowledge of emergency procedures.
- Ability to deal courteously and effectively with the public.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision, exercise considerable independence of judgment / action in the operation of the aquatic center.

Under the general direction of the Head Lifeguard, the Aquatic Leader is a member of the Aquatics leadership team and provides operational supervision of the aquatic area (pools, deck, change rooms, steam room, viewing area, etc.) and monitors pool use to ensure that the daily operation is following department policies and safety standards. The position involves providing mentorship to staff while performing lifeguard and instructional duties, a variety of custodial and facility maintenance tasks and assisting with the operation and delivery of aquatic programs, recreation programs and special events. This role requires the individual to demonstrate strong leadership abilities and possess a functional knowledge of pool chemistry and operating procedures.
