# Evacuation Order RESCIND

**Date:** July 30, 2024 **Time:** 15:00hrs

The **Evacuation Order**, issued for the below area by The Regional District of Central Kootenay is no longer required and is **RESCINDED** effective immediately. This **Evacuation Order RESCIND** applies to the rural areas surrounding the Village of Silverton in Electoral Area H affected by the Aylwin Creek Wildfire **Evacuation Order**. The **ORDER** is **RESCINDED** and an **Evacuation Alert** remains in place for the following properties (see attached map):


If a subsequent **Evacuation Order** is deemed necessary, a new Order will be made.
