



Evacuation Order RESCIND

Date: August 08, 2024

Time: 09:30hrs

The **Evacuation Order**, issued for the properties listed below by The Regional District of Central Kootenay is no longer required and is **RESCINDED effective as of August 08, 2024, 09:30hrs**. The **Evacuation Order RESCIND** applies to rural areas in Electoral Area D that are north of Bulmer's Pointe and east of Argenta Road, including the community of Argenta, and east of the southern portion of the Duncan FSR affected by the Argenta Creek Wildfire (N71058) **Evacuation Order** part of the Lavina Complex. The **ORDER** is **RESCINDED**.

However, an **Evacuation ALERT** remains in place for the areas listed above, including the following eighty-two (82) addresses and nineteen (19) parcel identifiers – PIDs (see attached map):

The **Evacuation ORDER** remains in effect for the area surrounding that portion of the Duncan FSR approximately 1.5km south of the Duncan Lake Dam, east of the Duncan River and Duncan Lake up to Glacier Creek Regional Park related to the Argenta Creek Wildfire (N71058). Duncan FSR north of Glacier Creek Regional Park remains closed due to the Glacier Creek Wildfire part of the Lavinia Complex.

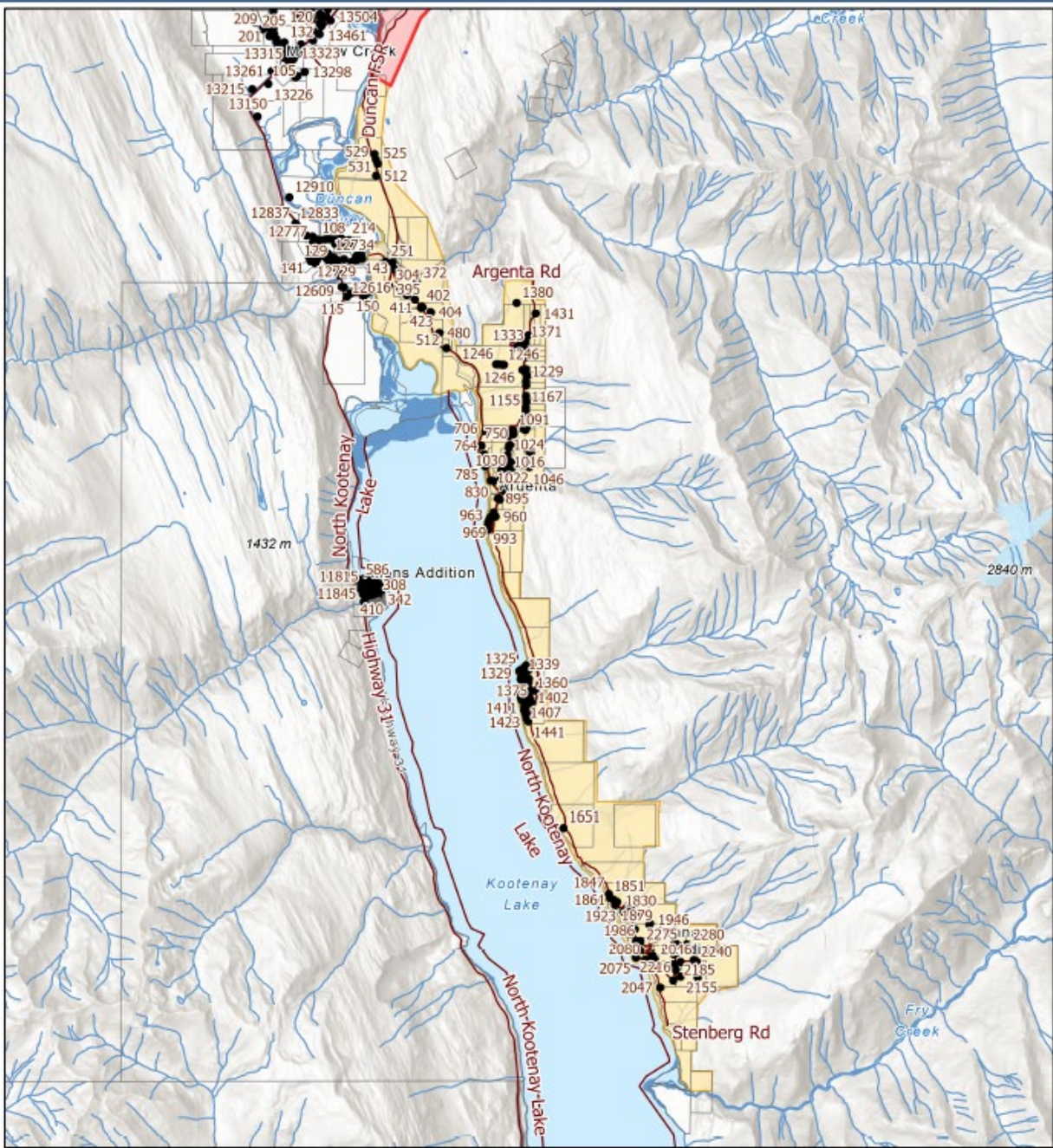

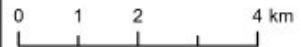
